



Town of Beacon Falls Natural Gas Line Extension Feasibility Study

At current prices, heating with natural gas is nearly half the cost of most other fuel types. The Town of Beacon Falls is conducting this voluntary survey of heating fuel consumers to gauge the demand for natural gas line extensions in the Town. The State of CT has made access to natural gas a primary goal in implementing its new energy and economic development plan. If there is sufficient support and public consensus, the Town of Beacon Falls will lobby the Yankee Gas Company to extend gas mains in Town, and consider the pursuit of financing opportunities that would assist businesses, building owners, and homeowners with financing the cost of utility gas main extensions and equipment upgrades/conversions to take full advantage of less expensive natural gas as a heating and process fuel.
