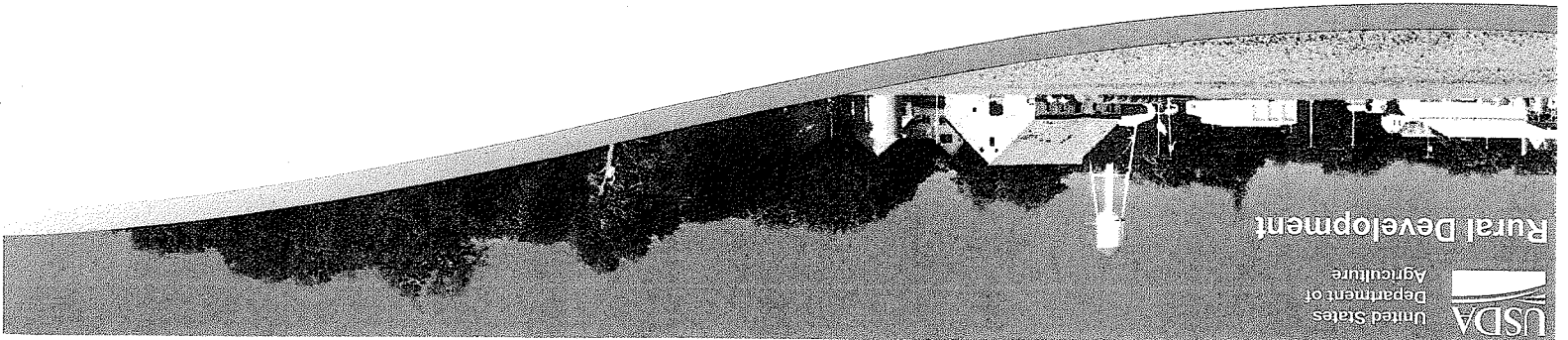




Water & Waste Disposal Loan & Grant Program

What does this program do?

This program provides funding for clean and reliable drinking water systems, sanitary sewage disposal, sanitary solid waste disposal, and storm water drainage to households and businesses in eligible rural areas.

Who may apply?

This program assists qualified applicants who are not otherwise able to obtain commercial credit on reasonable terms. Eligible applicants include:

- Most state and local governmental entities
- Private nonprofits
- Federally-recognized tribes

What is an eligible area?

Areas that may be served include:

- Rural areas and towns with populations of 10,000 or less - check eligible addresses
- Tribal lands in rural areas
- Colonias

What kinds of funding are available?

Long-term, low-interest loans. If funds are available, a grant may be combined with a loan if necessary to keep user costs reasonable.

How may the funds be used?

Funds may be used to finance the acquisition, construction or improvement of:

- Drinking water sourcing, treatment, storage and distribution
 - Sewer collection, transmission, treatment and disposal
 - Solid waste collection, disposal and closure
 - Storm water collection, transmission and disposal
- In some cases, funding may also be available for related activities such as:
- Legal and engineering fees
 - Land acquisition, water and land rights, permits and equipment

What is the loan term and rate?

The loan term is up to 40-year payback period, based on the useful life of the facilities financed with a fixed interest rate. The interest rate is based on the need for the project and the median household income of the area to be served. Contact us for details and current interest rates applicable for your project.

Are there additional requirements?

- Borrowers must have the legal authority to construct, operate and maintain the proposed services or facilities.
- All facilities receiving federal financing must be used for a public purpose.
- Partnerships with other federal, state, local, private and nonprofit entities that offer financial assistance are encouraged.
- Projects must be financially sustainable.

2. Garland to submit the bid package to Town of Beacon Falls to review and confirm the roof system meets their requirements.

3. Confirm the requirements from Town of Beacon Falls insurance company on the contractors liability and what codes they require.

4. Recommend Re-pointing the concrete wall on the Chimney and Domes and other buildings on campus.

Services provided by the Garland Company:

1. Provide Town of Beacon Falls with various roofing options to work within budget provided that meets the needs of the facility
 2. Once the new roof system is decided, provide specifications and bid drawings for Town of Beacon Falls
