He noted that this change would only pertain to the Industrial Park Zone and that it would be inline with the current Plan of Conservation and Development. It is a 2 acre parcel with public utilities already in place. It will generate tax money for the town. They would have classrooms and shooting lanes as well as a retail area. It will require state licensing.

III COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Chairman K. McDuffie asked if there were any comments from the public and Brian DeGeorge, 124 Cedar Lane, came forward and stated that he believes it will be a bonus for the town. Brian Blakeman, Oxford Ct. stated that he has 30 years in law enforcement and is a big advocate of gun safety, which includes a place to train.
