

If you have sold or junked a vehicle or moved out of state since October 1st, you may receive a credit on your July motor vehicle tax bill if you submit proper paperwork as follows:

TWO FORMS OF PROOF ARE REQUIRED TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT YOU NO LONGER OWN.

A plate receipt from the Department of Motor Vehicles PLUS

- 1) Bill of Sale
or
- 2) Junked car receipt
or
- 3) Out of state registration
or
- 4) Letter of total loss from your insurance company
or
- 5) Proof of ownership by another person
or
- 6) Copy of paper work showing the vehicle was traded in

Please note a Department of Motor Vehicles cancellation of license plate does not show that you have disposed of the vehicle, therefore a second form of proof is required to support an adjustment.
