Rules of Construction:

- 1. The boat must be made entirely of cardboard only. No size limit.
- 2. A minimum crew of 2 people is required. Crew members must be visible.
- 3. Any thickness corrugated cardboard.
- 4. No waxed, sealed or carbet tubes permitted.
- 5. Duct tape, paper tape and packing tape allowed on seams, joints and patches only.
- 6. DO NOT WRAP THE BOAT IN TAPE, PLASTIC AND/OR SHRINK WRAP in any manner.
- 7. You may use glue, such as Gorilla Glue or Elmers.
- 8. NO waterproof sealants, epoxy, tar, fiberglass, or other such materials.
- 9. No restrictions on decorations. We want your boat to be unique!
- 10. No nails, staples, bolts, hardware of any kind.
- 11. No restrictions on the oars. You can use any type of oar.
- 12. Boats must be propelled by oars or hands. No web gloves.
- 13. Boats must display a name.
- 14. You may paint or varnish your boat using water-based products only.
- 15. ALL CREW MUST COAST GUARD APPROVED PRESERVERS, BE ABLE TO
- 16. SWIM AND MUST WEAR SHOES OR WATER SHOES.
