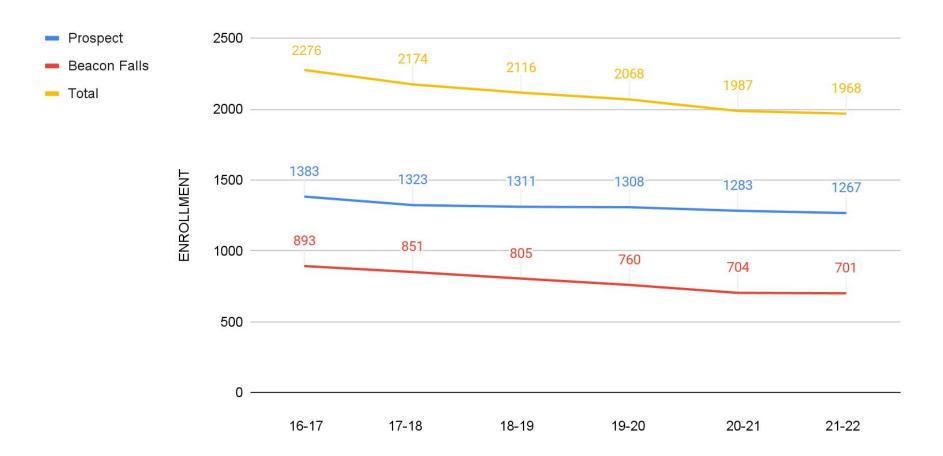

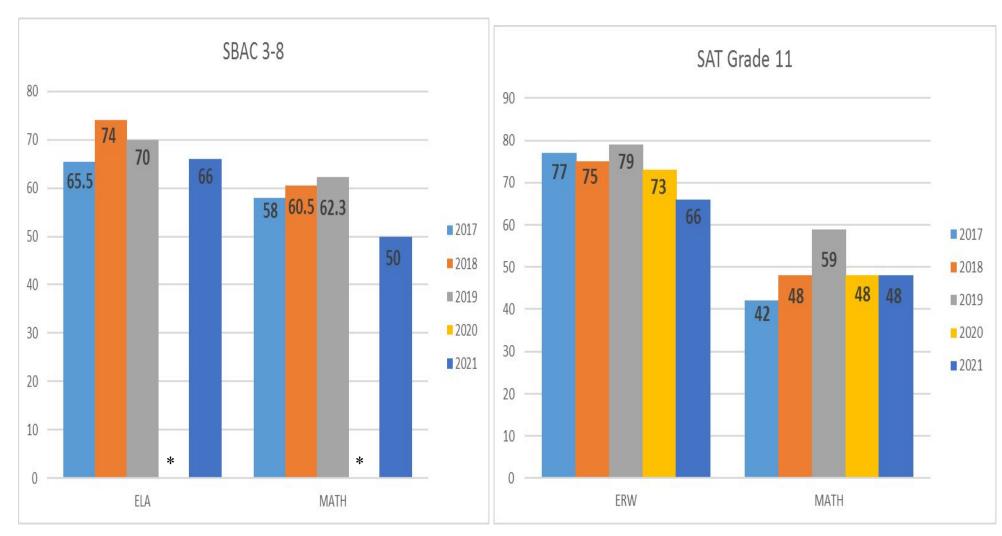




Growth in Student Achievement

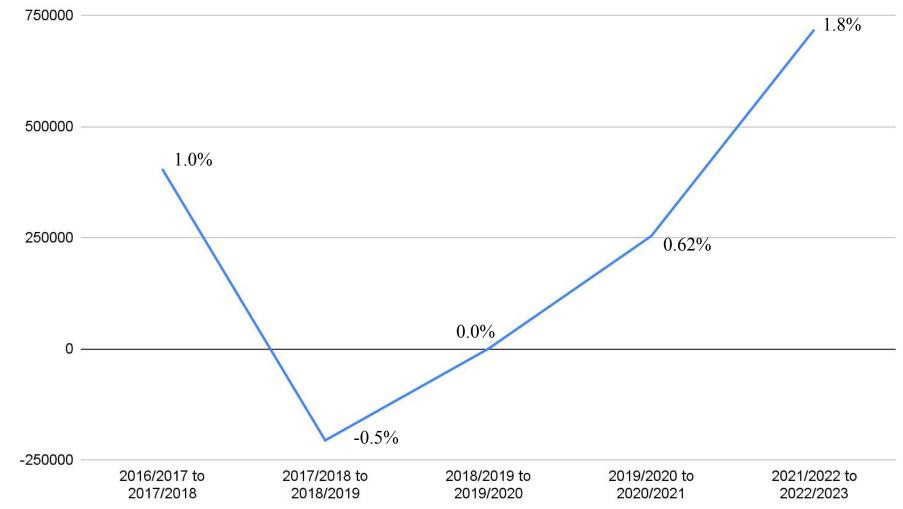

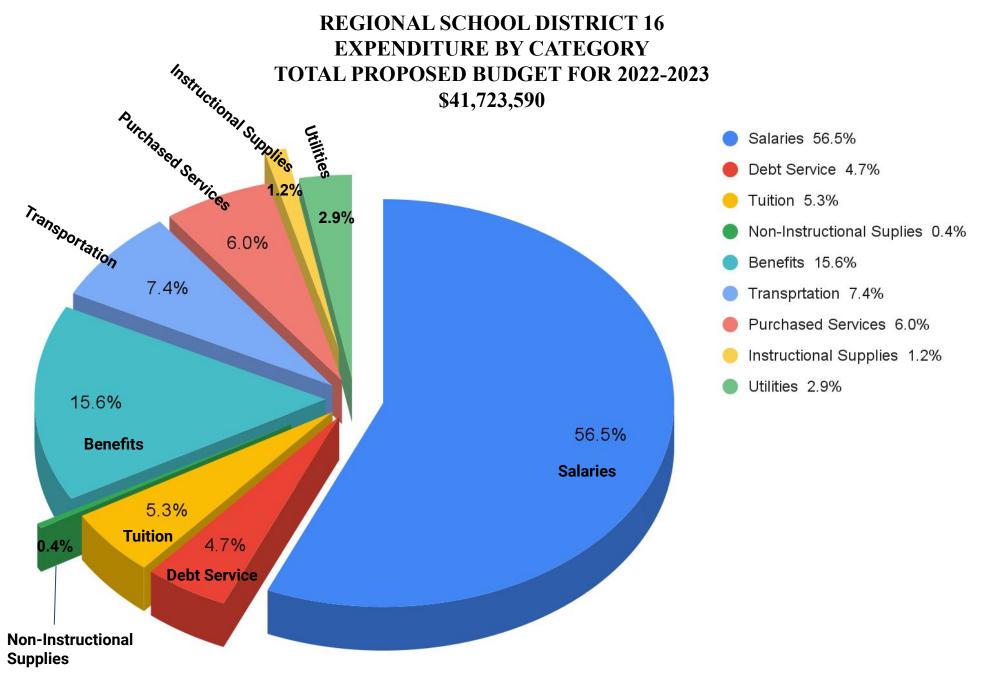

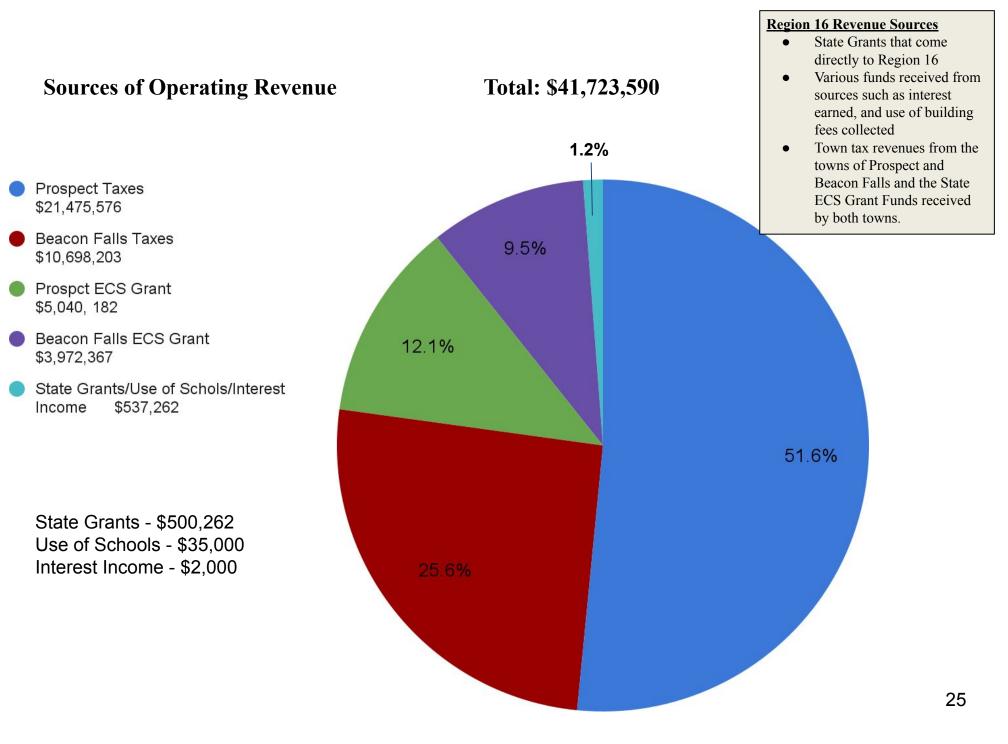
5 Year Budget Analysis
