Dear members of the Board of Selectmen,

Attached you will find the library's April service report and financial report.

Areas of note from the April Service report:

- The overall program attendance for adults and children is up by 75% from this time last year.
- Patron's have been able to bring in their own laptops and devices and use the library's wi-fi.
- Website visits are up from last month.
- The library is still offering homebound delivery to patrons who are unable to come into the library.
- Downloadable materials including audiobooks, digital music downloads and eBooks have maintained a steady increase of circulation.
- Items being lent to other libraries through interlibrary loan has increased.
- 48 children participated in an Easter wreath coloring craft.
- The monthly spice club program held in April featuring Jamaican curry & jerk chicken spices had 68 adults, 15 children and 2 young adults participate.
- The library hosted three weeks of Storytime to go. 54 children and 15 adults picked up physical bags. 24 children and 8 adults participated virtually.
- The teen baking program (triple chocolate dump cake) had 19 participants.
- Chef Rob's spring cooking class had 48 virtual participants. The class focused on healthy pasta salads and an easy springtime dessert.
- Grounded Goodwife's zoom program "Fit as a Fiddle" had 13 participants. This is the first in a series of programs funded by the CCF to improve the health and quality of life for older patrons.
- The Earth Day tree giveaway (trees provided by Neighborhood Forest) had 64 children and 42 adult participants.

Areas of note regarding the April FY 20-21 Financial Report:

• The overall total of expenditures for the library is at 77% which is where it is to be expected. Professional development in person attendance has been difficult due to the pandemic. Each of the librarians has registered to attend the CLA conference virtually in May. The computer line item is 97% expended. Recently our website crashed, and we had to have it restored. The part time staff have been working again and providing coverage.

Upcoming programs include a Mother's Day take & make craft for children, another monthly spice bag, Chef Rob's virtual salsa and guacamole class, the second Grounded Goodwife program "What to grow in your medicinal herb garden", a virtual workshop presented by AAA on Social Security and retirement planning, an adult take & make herb garden craft and an outdoor teen program presented by Riverside Reptiles. We are hoping to resume story time on Fridays outdoors in mid-May. Summer reading registration will begin May 17th with programs for adults, teens, and children.

Thank you for your continued support of the Beacon Falls Public Library.
