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Dear members of the Board of Selectmen,

Attached you will find the library's May service report and financial report.

Areas of note from the May Service report:

The overall program attendance for adults and children is up by 65% from this time last year.

BEACON FALLS PUBLIC LIBRARY

- Homebound delivery has seen a 42% increase.
- Downloadable materials including audiobooks, digital music downloads and eBooks have maintained a steady increase of circulation.
- Items being lent to other libraries through interlibrary loan has increased by 25%.
- 24 children participated in the Mother's Day Coaster Craft.
- Chef Rob held a virtual cooking class making guacamole and salsa. 24 adults viewed it live and 15 patrons viewed the recording.
- The May spice bag had 72 adults, 15 children and 3 teen participants.
- DEEP held the first in a series of environmental webinars with 6 adults participating virtually.
- The adult herb garden take & make craft had 19 adults participate.
- Grounded Goodwife held the second zoom program "What to grow in your medicinal herb garden" sponsored by the Connecticut Community Foundation. 11 adults participated.
- The Webb Satellite Webinar hosted by NASA had 5 adults and 14 teen participants.
- AAA offered a Social Security planning webinar which had 16 adult participants.
- Riverside Reptiles Education Center came for a program in the library. This program was well received.

Areas of note regarding the May FY 20-21 Financial Report:

The overall total of expenditures for the library is at 84% which is where it is to be expected. Professional development training has been difficult this year due to the pandemic. Opportunities were limited. The part time staff have been working again and providing coverage. The funds in the telephone line item were transferred to the library materials line item.

Upcoming children's activities include a forest jar craft held here at the library and a tie dye party, which will be our opening program for summer reading. Summer reading will officially kick off on June 28th and run for six weeks. A "break in box" for teens will be offered. Adult programs will include the spice club bag for June, a zoom program from Grounded Goodwife where they will teach viewers how to make their own ginger ale and vanilla/almond extracts, a DEEP webinar and adult string art craft. We will continue to promote library card sign ups and card renewals.
