Dear members of the Board of Selectmen,

Attached you will find the library's August service report and financial report.

Areas of note from the August Service report:

• The overall program attendance for adults and children has increased by 16% with more programs for adults and children being offered.

BEACON FALLS PUBLIC LIBRARY

- The library offered space for one of the Laurel Ledge teachers to tutor students over the summer. In total, 37 tutoring sessions took place.
- Overall circulation of materials has increased 83%
- Items being lent and borrowed through interlibrary loan has increased.
- Notary services are still being widely utilized in the library.
- The 6-week summer reading program finished in August with children logging 478 hours of reading.
- A Gnome & Fairy Lawn Party was held at the Town Hall. 27 kids and 19 adults participated.
- A pizza and ice cream party were held at the rec center. Riverside Reptile Center joined us to put on a reptile presentation. 38 adults, 5 teens and 26 kids joined us for this end of summer celebration.
- 47 patrons joined us for an outdoor movie night held at the rec field. Unfortunately, it was cut short by the rain.
- Adults had a tie-dye night with Seymour Blank Canvas.
- We started our monthly coffee club with 72 participants. We have partnered with local roasters "Great Minds Coffee" to supply the various types of coffee.
- The teens had a "Hunt A Killer Night" with 12 teens participating.
- Chef Rob hosted summer cooking class online with dates on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup> of August.
- An all-ages Lotus Lantern Workshop put on by the Korean Spirit and Culture Promotion Project was held at the Senior Center.

Areas of note regarding the August FY 21 22 Financial Report:

• The computer line is 76% expended. This is common for the start of the fiscal year with the purchase of databases for the library. Other line items have seen an increase for this time compared to last year. With the increase of library patrons being able to enter the library the requests for titles have increased causing an increase in spending in the library material lines. The programming line has also seen increased spending with the purchasing of materials for take and make crafts. All the other line items are where they are expected.

Upcoming events for this month include a presentation by Monica Peterson called "Tales of Ireland". The Friends of Beacon Falls Library will be hosting a vendor fair September 18<sup>th</sup> on the St. Michael's green. Our school year programming begins this month with an art exploration craft for elementary school children and an anime movie club for the teens. We are also working as a NASA partner to create programming to celebrate the upcoming launch of the James Webb Space Telescope.

Thank you for your continued support of the Beacon Falls Public Library.
