Dear members of the Board of Selectmen,

Attached you will find the library's March service report and financial report.

Areas of note from the March Service report:

• The overall total of adults and children participating in library programs is up by over 100% from last year to this year. The library is still offering zoom programs and take and make activities for adults and children.

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- The library continues to offer homebound deliveries to patrons who are unable to pick up library materials during curbside pickup allotted times. The use of this service is up 300%.
- Circulation of downloadable audiobooks, e-books, music, and downloadable videos are up. The library offers hoopla digital and Overdrive for their downloadable services.
- The "other" category on the service report has increased due to mailing out seed packets to patrons. This service was offered in February and continued through March.
- The percentage of library materials being lent through interlibrary loan was up slightly for March.
- The library offered four weeks of Story Time to Go with 52 children and 14 adults picking up bags and 24 children and 8 adults participating with the digital only materials.
- The St. Patrick's Day Brownie Baking program for teens had 36 participants.
- The monthly spice club program held on March 11, 2021 was up to 82 adults, 27 children and 5 teens.
- The children's St. Patrick's Day suncatcher take & make craft had 36 child participants.
- On March 27th, the library held a zoom cooking class with Chef Rob. He taught participants how
 to make two different types of dog treats (the recording will be available on our website). We had
 20 adults and 2 children follow along. Many of the participants followed the recipes and baked
 along with him making it a very interactive program.

Areas of note regarding the March FY 20-21 Financial Report:

• The overall total of expenditures for the library is at 69% which is where it is to be expected. The part time staff are back with the library being open to the public. It has still been difficult to find in person professional development opportunities for the staff while covid protocols are in place. This is the reason that line item is currently 25% expended.

In April, the library will continue the monthly spice club. This month will be the last story time to go bags. We have a Facebook Live cooking class with Chef Rob scheduled. There will be an Earth Day tree giveaway reaching almost 100 families. The Grounded Goodwife will host a zoom program on herbology for personal health.
