Patrolling of Parks & Checking for Compliance

Matthies Park

Playground age limit sign posted at playground located at the pavilion. All trails remain closed to tree issues on the White and Orange trails.



Riverbend Park

Still waiting on DEEP regarding town authority on the Naugatuck River (two emails/5 phone calls). Everyone fishing has been in compliance in possessing a current fishing license and appropriate required Trout/Salmon stamps.

Toby's Pond

Additional "No Parking" signs have been installed next to the pavilion along with new signage at the turnaround, to preclude individuals from blocking the Metro-North and town gates.



Everyone fishing has been in compliance in possessing a current fishing license and in compliance with waterway rules.
