A. **APPLICATION FOR STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN REVIEW:**

- No Impact Area of disturbance less than 1 acre.
- Waiver (Approval By Inland Wetlands Commission)
- 1-5 acres (Stormwater Management Plan Reviewed and Approved by Inland Wetlands Commission)
- 5-10 acres (Stormwater Management Plan Required and Approved by Commission)
- 10-50 acres (Stormwater Management Plan Required and Reviewed by Commission)
- >50 acres (Stormwater Management Plan Required and Reviewed by Commission)

Note: SITES: >5 ACRES (regardless of phasing) require CTDEP registration under General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Waste water from Construction Activities thirty (30) days before initiation of construction activities. SITES >10 ACRES (regardless of phasing require CTDEP General Permit Registration and CTDEP Stormwater Management Plan review thirty (30) days before initiation of construction activities.

B. **NOTIFICATION: To Planning and Zoning, Building, and/or Health Department that no Stormwater Management Plan is required due to "Area of Disturbance" being less than 1 acre or waiver granted. (Approval by Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission).**

FEE SCHEDULE

Application and Stormwater Management Plan Fees are not refundable.

No permit will be issued until all fees are paid.

Failure to pay fees, or part thereof, constitutes grounds for denial. The Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission (IWWC) may settle a time limit for additional fee payment.

All fees are to be paid prior to Certificate of Occupancy sign-off. The Commission may require payment by cash, check, or certified check made payable to: "Beacon Falls Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission".

Each building lot site plan is considered a separate application and requires separate fees.

The Town of Beacon Falls Boards, Commissions, etc. are exempt from fee requirements (except state fees). The Beacon Falls Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission may, in its sole discretion, waive all or part of its scheduled fees.

PLEASE NOTE: The applicant will be required to cover the costs of special consultants for legal, engineering/ technical, and/ or environmental reviews, as deemed necessary by the Beacon Falls Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission, at any time during the period from initial review through final site inspection.

BEACON FALLS INLAND WETLANDS & WATERCOURSES COMMISSION

Inland Wetland & Watercourses Enforcement

VIOLATIONS:

- A. Failure to install and maintain silt control measures – silt fence, hay bales, riprap, plantings, etc.
- B. Filling in regulated area -- wetland swamp/ stream
- C. Clearing brush – cutting trees adjacent to or upslope from wetlands or watercourses
- D. Diverting, damming or otherwise changing the course of a watercourse
- E. Discarding or allowing litter and debris to enter wetland or conservation area
- F. Discharge of silt, colloidal material, chemicals, polluted materials and other materials into a wetland or stream
- G. Changing actual locations of buildings (and/or driveways, utilities, slopes) from location on approved application
- H. Failure to maintain sediment control measures after construction is completed
- I. Failure to install conservation wetland boundary markers
- J. Relocation, removal or destruction of boundary markers
- K. Planting non-native or invasive plants in wetlands or conservation area

FINE STRUCTURE:

1.	Minor infraction	\$60.00
2.	First infraction:	\$120.00
3.	Repeat infractions: (ONE)	\$250.00
4.	Repeat infractions: (TWO)	\$500.00
5.	Repeat infractions: (THREE OR MORE)	\$1,000.00
6.	Cease and desist on building permit plus per day fine, remedial costs for clean up and cost of repairs of damage to wetlands	\$150.00 per day
7.	Per day charge for major infractions which cause public and environmental safety and/or irreversible damage	\$1,000.00 per day
8.	Post Construction Stormwater Ordinance	\$5000.00 and/or imprisonment not exceeding one (1 year)or both
9.	Illicit Discharge Ordinance	\$1,000.00 per incident/day and/or imprisonment for a period of time not to exceed thirty (30) days.
